The Committee discussed the lack of applications received so far for the temporary art display. The decision was made to postpone the deadline to May 1. The applications will be resent to the local papers and the art schools at Eastern, Washtenaw Community College, Center for Creative Studies, and the University of Michigan.

The 2012-2013 budget request will be \$10,000 as described in the public art plan.

The Committee discussed potential upcoming projects. Paul will be bringing back more detailed information from the Watershed Council on their decorative banner project. We will plan to do the Box City again at Apple Daze and at the Farmers Market. A suggestion was made about a great blue heron decorating contest. Businesses could decorate metal great blue herons for display outside of their businesses. Victoria volunteered to gather more information on this idea.

The Yellow Door breakfasts are scheduled for June 2 and August 10. Paul has received the supplies from the Chelsea family that hosted the breakfasts. A sign-up sheet will be available at the May meeting for help with set-up, running the event and clean-up.
