The June meeting notes were reviewed and no changes were made.

The Committee discussed the Plein Air Event. The focus now is on publicity to the general public. Victoria informed the Committee she received a donation of jewelry from Lewis Jewelers. Since we had decided not to pursue a raffle license this year, it will be used as a door prize. Committee members volunteered to spread the word to different areas: Rich will discuss it at DDA, Paul will take the flyers to the Townie Party, James will distribute them at the Summer Music Series and Ann Arbor Art Center. Victoria worked with the Dexter Daze Committee to secure a booth for the Committee. Committee members were asked to sign up for volunteer hours during the event and the week prior at Dexter Daze.

The Committee discussed the updated design of the troll submitted by Wendy Baker. Paul Cousins made a motion, seconded by James Davis to recommend the sculpture to the Selection Committee in a location closer to the bridge than the previously discussed beam. The motion passed unanimously.

The advertisements are out for the 2013 temporary sculpture display. Submissions are due on July 12, 2013.

The Committee discussed the proposed location of the bicycle sculpture after receiving the update that the proposed location along the Dexter Huron Path near the DPW will not work due to the railroad right-of-way issues. The Committee is still in support of finding a location in that area, potentially in the grass area in front of the Cider Mill or in the area between the tracks and CMR. The Committee supports sending it to the Selection Committee for their feedback.

Paul updated the Committee that the Village received a \$2,000 grant from the Chelsea Area Wellness Foundation to produce the new walking maps.
