Notes from the July meeting were reviewed and no changes were made.

Temporary Art Display. The Committee reviewed the quote from Patti Schwarz/Deb Greer and decided to move ahead with the project using the revenues received from Plein Air and the Committee's \$10,000 budget. The Committee will select 3-5 locations and work with the Garden Club to create an accompanying garden. The locations discussed were LaFontaine, Mill Creek Park, Dexter District Library, and the area in front of Huron Camera.

Public Art Updates. We have the pole for the bike sculpture. We are waiting until the design of the Border to Border Trail is complete to finalize the location. Construction is expected in Spring 2015. Cheryl Willoughby discussed the idea of having David Zinn create mini permanent murals using a character he creates specifically for Dexter. These would be done on the lower portion of building walls and be an attraction for children. Cheryl will work with David to create a proposal for the work.

Katherine McCormick/Gordon Hall Project. Victoria will meet with Dan Cooney over the winter regarding how to move forward with this project.

Historic Map. The Committee discussed creating a historical site/architecture map using the public art map as a base.
