



I can't remember a time in my life before I was captivated by the creative process and making things. Some of my earliest memories are of painting on cardboard on the kitchen floor, making clay monsters, giving drawings to friends at preschool, and trying to nail wood scraps together in my fathers little basement shop.

I have always made things. It is a fundamental part of who I am.

I enjoy exploring the nature and feel of materials and processes, and both pushing these to their limits as well as allowing each material's and processes' unique characteristics and “feel” to guide me in their use towards the creation of my art.

I am interested in the contrast and interaction between organic and inorganic shapes, forms and substances, as well as the interplay between organic processes of creation such as hands on emotional painting and sculpting, and the more rigid and mechanical processes of production such as casting and printmaking. I use these contrasting and complimentary techniques and impulses to capture images, forms and feelings that speak to me and are a personal reflection of my observations, reactions, and interpretations of both the world around me, and of my own inner world and experiences in my life.

I hope that my art can be enjoyed by its viewers as much as I enjoy making it, and that it might cause a viewer to feel some of the curiosity and intrigue that drives me to explore and create.



Dear Committee,

The intent of this proposal for the Dexter Gardens Sculptures Art Areas is to provide beauty, aestheticism, functionality, and history and its relationship to Michigan as well as its multi-diversity and cultural and global qualities and the city of its locale as represented through a continuum of images that goes through the history of the area and its people, the history, past, present, current and future of all of the various offerings here. I like to provide for color and form in terms of environmental and architectural imagery and structures. One must keep in mind that each one is durable, graffiti proof, yet aesthetic and practical while beautiful.

This idea very much revolves around taking a variety of images and color and techniques and arranging them to dramatic yet informative, even nostalgic in some cases and brings a lot of color into the area.

For the Dexter Gardens Sculptures Show, I am proposing any of a variety of undulation, s-curve and swirl and wave sculptures made out of brushed aluminum. They very much take their inspiration from the ocean but also from relating moving shapes in X, Y, and Z space. The pieces I have sent are The Slice and The Single Twist, and a variety of other images related to nature.

I have tried to include a variety of images that are complimentary to and/or related to nature and gardens, such as the Striped Cherub, and the Turtle.

As far as imagery goes, this job could avail almost any type of idea from more traditional to contemporary or a combination of both which is what I like to do.

I have finished working on the Metropark Railway Station in Iselin, New Jersey for New Jersey Transit. This station is a very large hub on the East Coast with trains that are not only local, but also going to Washington, New York and Boston. It has a lot of traffic and a lot of design and safety issues, which I met with my proposals for laminated glass windscreens and mural work also. I have included some of the small samples of glass in slides in my presentation. Metropark is like a small city that is very industrial and has certain similarities to the areas of both of these stations. The future design, including my work is very contemporary, but also historical in nature and I did something similar in trying to incorporate a large variety of imagery, utilizing imagery from the surrounding areas, having a very contemporary feel to it, while looking back at the past as well to be able to see the roots of the area to be designed. I am also currently working on a large - 6 foot by 70 foot semi-circular granite wall that will have a drawing of a timescape history of the Bridgewater, New Jersey area etched by machine into it. Both of these jobs are exterior, with all the considerations that go with that in nature.

I have tried to create designs that are at once beautiful, aesthetic, exhilarating, functional, safe, and unique. I hope that you will find them to be so.

I look forward to hearing from you soon and hope that my presentation meets with your approval.






1. The Single Twist- Can be any Dimension,




Artist Statement:

This inquisitive bronze turtle will serve as a friendly greeting to residents and visitors in all seasons, connecting our busy lives with the natural environment and reminding us to slow down and take it easy. We'll get "there" when we get there!

My turtles tend to draw a crowd wherever they are located, lighting up the faces of children and delighting adults with their subtle yet powerful reminder to take a moment to slow down and simply enjoy our surroundings. They are personable and act as a magnet for visitors, especially children, who engage in conversations with the turtles and are reluctant to leave them. This sculpture is sure to become a destination by itself.

My bronze turtles have been featured in several public exhibitions and are also now a part of numerous private collections.

I have been a professional artist for over 30 years and, while I have been creating turtles in clay for many years, I have made the transition to bronze in the last few years. This has been an exciting new part of my journey as an artist and, by working in bronze, has made it possible to bring a peaceful quiet to public settings where durability is important. My clay sculptures have always attracted an intense and positive response from the public, and, to my delight, the response to my bronzed turtles has been even more enthusiastic!

Two years ago I was awarded an Individual Artist Grant through the Arts Council of Greater Lansing. With this support I was able to work with the Arts Council to have one of my turtle sculptures bronzed. As part of the grant process I initiated and developed a relationship with the Children's Garden in the Michigan State University Horticulture Garden to create a public outdoor presentation of the process of making both clay and bronze sculptures.

Through this relationship with the Lansing Arts Council, my bronze turtle was chosen to be featured on a billboard in the Lansing area. This relationship also helped me to successfully compete for a state wide grant from the Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs to attend a national ceramics conference in Milwaukee, Wisconsin in 2014.

Working with the Lansing Art Gallery, one of my turtle sculptures was selected by a panel review process for a large scale outdoor public exhibition in the summer of 2014. Immediately following this exhibition, the Grand Rapids Public Museum selected the entire family of turtles for exhibition in the world's largest public art exhibition, ArtPrize in Grand Rapids, Michigan. This exhibit includes the work of over 1500 artists and encompasses the entire central business district. My turtle family was voted one of the top 25 sculptures in the Peoples' Choice Awards.

My turtle sculptures are intended for outdoor display. Created in the tradition of classic bronze sculptures, they are durable and attractive in all seasons. I usually construct a base of cement landscaping materials which conceals the weights, cables and locks that safely secure the sculpture in a public setting. This turtle is approximately 13 inches in diameter and weighs approximately 20 pounds. The base would be 32" high and 16" in diameter at the top. The entire installation is approximately 36" high. I would, however, be happy to work with your "local garden enthusiasts" to design another installation strategy that fits their vision.




