


HUDSON MILLS – DEXTER NON-MOTORIZED TRAIL

HURON-CLINTON METROPOLITAN AUTHORITY



This project will construct a 2.7 mile asphalt-surfaced trail, including 1600 feet of boardwalk, and a steel pedestrian bridge. The trail winds through timber forest and open fields along the west side of the Huron River.

This trail will extend from the southern end of Hudson Mills' existing west side trail and connect to the northern end of the City of Dexter's Warrior Park trail. The trail will be an integral park of Washtenaw County's 35-mile Border-to-Border trail.

The construction of this project is made possible by the generous contributions from, and partnership with, Washtenaw County Parks & Recreation Commission, Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) Surface Transportation Program, and the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund.
