A. 2014 Arbor Day Wrap-up

Ms. Aniol reported there were very few seedlings left over on Friday afternoon. Dexter Mill agreed to distribute them on Saturday. Board members commented on the quality of the plant material and asked where it came from. Ms. Aniol stated that seedlings were ordered from the Washtenaw Conservation District. Consensus of the board was to order from them again.

Board discussed having a large poster to explain "what is Arbor Day" on display next year, with language that the event is sponsored by the Village. Board consensus was to only hand out seedlings at the library and Dexter Mill next year.

B. 2014 Spring Planting Wrap-up

The Board reviewed the tree planting spreadsheet and notice to property owner regarding installation of new tree. The Board also decided to plant two trees each spring planting season in Mill Creek Park, in consultation with the PaRC Board.

New Business

A. Horseshoe Park

Board discussed the possibility of planting trees at Horseshoe Park in conjunction with the construction of a new shelter. Consensus was to engage PaRC for design and placement before planting trees in spring 2015. The Board also decided it would take a field trip to the park before any trees are removed this summer.
