These are additional edit suggestions to the Articles (not specifically) related to the amendments drafted and submitted in the packet (but on the same pages so they stopped me):

- 2.01 (C): second sentence, "used" and "occupied" should be in quotes, I'm sorry I didn't catch it earlier
- 2.02 "Accessory use, building, or structure:" and "Accessory use or accessory", I don't believe there should be a comma after, "which is," Maybe those commas need to be colons, but I don't think they should be commas
- There are some missing commas and apostrophes in other definitions but a grammar check should find those and they're not as impactful related to understanding what's being said as the one above.
- 3.28 B.2.
 - I think this should be two separate items, the second starting with, "The annual permit fee..."
 - The first sentence, to me, implies that all permits are annual and precludes anyone applying after the start date. I would prefer to see, "All OSA permits expire on September 30 following the issue date."
- 3.28.3: I think "Accord Certificate of Liability Insurance" should just be "Certificate of Liability Insurance". If we leave "Accord" in (it is a standard form, I'm not sure it's necessary to what we're asking for), it should be spelled, "ACORD" (one "C" and all caps).
- 3.28.C.1: "OSA" should be "OSAs" or "an OSA"
- 14.02.F / 15.02.E / 15(A).02.E.: I would put "(OSA)" after "Outdoor Service Areas" because these are new/separate Articles
