Re: November 1<sup>st</sup> – November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Police Services Monthly Report

During the month of November there were 186 calls for service (including traffic stops). Deputies conducted 63 traffic stops during this time with 18 citations issued.

General Fund services received:

- SRP (Traffic Services) spent 135 minutes of traffic related activity in the city.
- County Wide deputies spent 220 minutes assisting in the city.

Noteworthy events in Dexter City during last month include:

- On 11/20/18 deputies investigated an incident where a subject tried to pass a counterfeit bill at the Dexter Pharmacy. The suspect came in to pick up a prescription and attempted to pay with a fake \$100 bill. When the clerk checked the bill and found it to be fake the suspect advised he knew it was and was just joking. They notified us and we made contact with the suspect who was still in the store. The suspect, who initially lied about his name, was identified and transported to the WC Jail pending charges.
- On 11/26/18 deputies responded to the 3000 block of Baker Road for the report of a theft that had occurred sometime over the previous two days. The caller had left her 1988 Honda motorcycle in the driveway and left for a couple days to see family. When she came back she noticed that it was gone. There are no witnesses to the theft and no suspects have been identified at this point.

Deputies continue to attend training throughout the year in efforts to improve overall service. Recent training initiatives include:

- All staff will be attending Rescue Task Force and Bystander Intervention training this month

Banked Hours Update:

- We have two open positions at this time; both due to low staffing levels. These hours will be used to fill overtime shifts and excess hours will be banked for future use.

- 320 hours banked due to vacant positions
- 392 hours used to fill vacant shifts – **Non Billable**
- Total banked hours remaining as of 12/1/18 – **93**

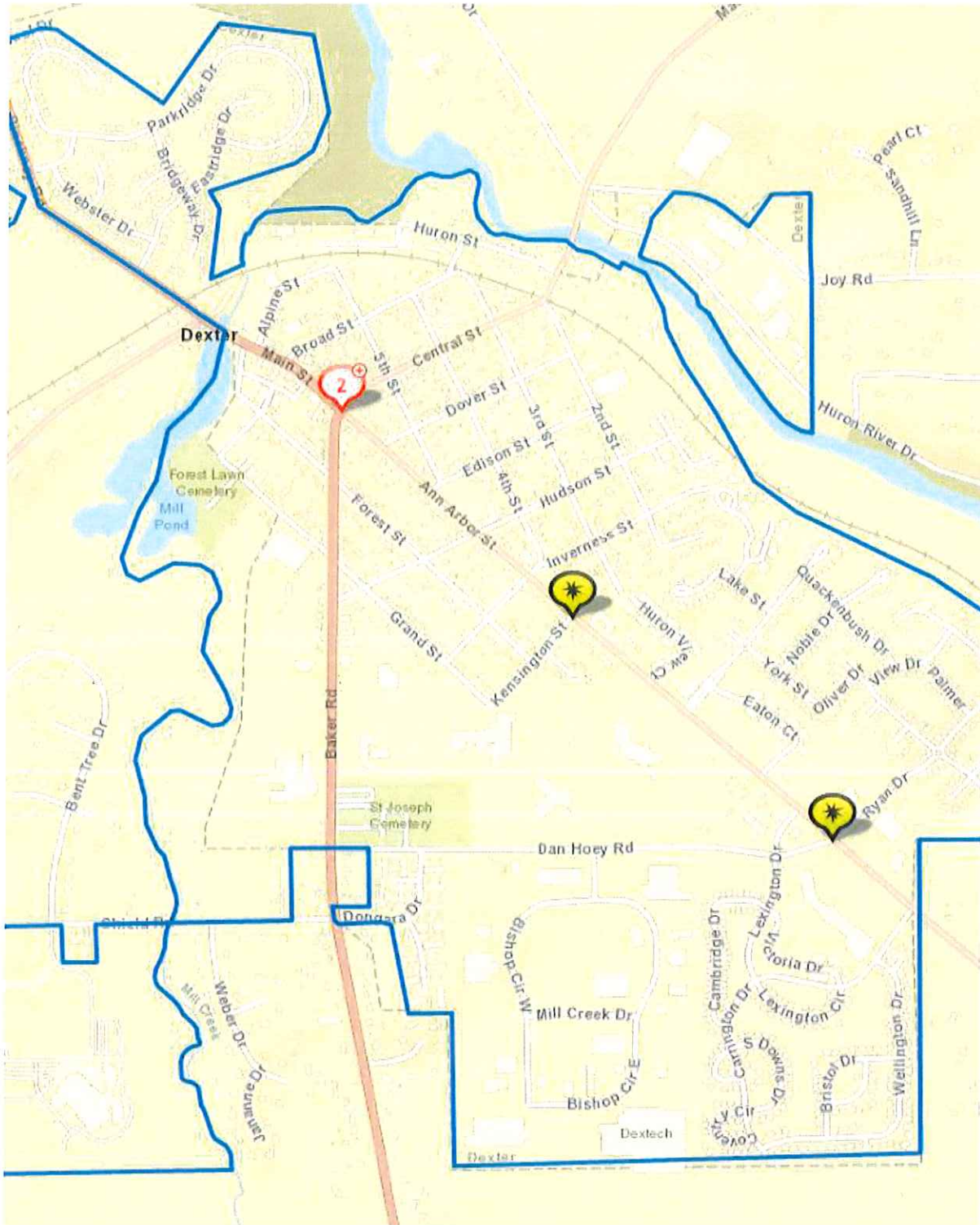

## PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

- WHAT:** Public Information Meeting regarding Border-to-Border Trail projects
- WHEN:** Wednesday, January 9, 2019 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.
- WHERE:** Dexter Public Library – Lower Level Meeting Room (255 Alpine, Dexter, MI 48130)
- WHO:** The Washtenaw County Parks and Recreation Commission  
Washtenaw County Road Commission  
Huron-Clinton Metroparks  
Huron Waterloo Pathways Initiative
- WHY:** This public informational meeting will discuss two Border-to-Border Trail (B2B) projects. The meeting will begin with a presentation followed by an open house discussion format where individuals can discuss the projects with staff.

The first project will begin construction in January 2019. It begins in Dexter Huron Metropark and ends at the intersection of Zeeb Road and Huron River Drive (1.2 miles). The trail is mostly within the Metropark but also includes portions in the railroad and road rights of way. The work includes two new pedestrian bridges over the Huron River, earthwork, vegetation removal, paving of an asphalt trail, boardwalk, and other related improvements. The river may be temporarily closed for safety reasons while placing bridges. Construction is expected to be completed in the fall of 2019.

The second project is in the engineering and design phase. The trail begins at the intersection of Zeeb Road and Huron River Drive and is proposed to roughly parallel the railroad on the south side of Huron River Drive to Delhi Metropark. The project team has completed preliminary designs, environmental and archeological research and now seeks public feedback on the proposed trail alignment. Construction may occur as soon as 2020.
