Good evening Mr. Breyer,

I respectfully ask that you and City Council consider the following proposed amendment to the summary of my statement given May 26, 2020 as it currently appears in the [meeting packet for Monday's \(6/8\) Council meeting](#).

As currently worded, my statement summary reads:

Jamie Griffin of 463 Preston Circle and Treasurer of the Dexter Citizens for Responsible Government spoke about the type of housing being proposed by Avalon and she does not believe that Dexter needs this type of housing in such a close proximity with the Dexter Schools. She also raised issues with the process and handling of this project.

I propose the following amendment:

Jamie Griffin of 463 Preston Circle and Treasurer of the Dexter Citizens for Responsible Government expressed concerns about the mismatch between the proposed development and Dexter's housing needs, knowingly and intentionally placing active drug users across the street from the Dexter Schools, using public funds to build \$400,000 apartments, and several improprieties on the part of city staff.

Both statements are 58 words, yet the proposed revision is a more specific, and, thus, more meaningful, characterization of my statement.
