Pay: \$14.00/hour

Nature of Work: The City of Dexter's Farmers Market Manager is a paid part-time position. The Market Manager will work under the direction of the City Manager or their designee. The Market Manager will be responsible for the successful operation of the Dexter Farmers Market. This includes: managing the Market during its hours of operation and coordinating market day logistics such as assignment of stalls, customer service, programming, community group participation, and monitoring safety and cleanliness. The position will also be responsible for such duties as: vendor recruitment, advertisement, engaging community partners, event planning, and implementation of food assistance programs at the Market. The Manager will also be required to produce an end of the season report that will be distributed to City Council and made available on the City website.

Desired Qualifications:

- Experience with Microsoft Office, including Word and Excel;
- Event promotion/marketing/volunteer coordination experience;
- Self-motivation to complete projects and tasks;
- Experience working with the public.

Work Schedule: Estimated 450 hours of work breaks down as follow:

- Attendance at Tuesday Market – 21 days at 4 hours per day (84 hours)
 - o 2 pm to 6 pm

- Pre-Season Planning/Post Season Wrap Up – Approximately 80 hours
