NOTICE OF PLANNING COMMISSION VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING
TO CONSIDER 2020-2025 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN

Pursuant to Michigan Public Act 33 of 2008 (the Planning Enabling Act), as amended, and Executive Order 2020-15 (COVID-19), notice is hereby given that the City of Dexter Planning Commission will conduct a virtual public hearing on Monday, April 6, 2020, at 7:00 pm. The purpose of the public hearing is to consider the proposed City of Dexter 2020-2025 Capital Improvements Plan (CIP), and take comments from the public. Parties interested in participating in the virtual public hearing may gain access from the city's website www.dextermi.gov

The CIP is a program that projects and coordinates public expenditures for improvements to the transportation and utility systems, municipal facilities, and other capital improvement projects over a six-year period. Preparation of the capital improvements plan is done under the authority of the PA 33 of 2008, the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, as amended. It is the Planning Commission's goal that the CIP be used as a tool to implement the City's Master Plan and assist in the City's financial planning.

All comments must be received no later than one hour before the start of the meeting (i.e. 6:00 pm, Monday, April 6, 2020).
