## NOTICE OF PLANNING COMMISSION VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARINGS REGARDING TEXTS AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCE, A SPECIAL LAND USE APPLICATION AND THE 2021-2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN

Pursuant to Michigan Public Act 110 of 2006 (the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act), as amended, and state law, notice is hereby given that the City of Dexter Planning Commission will conduct a virtual meeting and three (3) public hearings on Monday, May 3, 2021, at 7:00 pm. **Public Hearing 1:** The purpose of the first public hearing is to consider text amendments to the City of Dexter Zoning Ordinance, to establish self-storage facilities, as a special land use in the I-1 District, subject to the specific requirements, and to establish off-street parking requirements for self-storage facilities.

The following Articles and Sections of the City of Dexter Zoning Ordinance will be considered:

- 1. Amend Article II, Definitions, §2.02 Definitions
- 2. Amend Article V, Parking and Loading, §5.03A Parking Space Numerical Requirements Industrial
- 3. Amend Article VIII, Special Land Uses,
  - a. §8.11(A), Special Land Use Specific Requirements, Listing
  - §8.11(B), Special Land Use Specific Requirements, List of specific requirements by use
- 4. Amend Article XVI, I-1 Limited Industrial District, §16.03, Special Land Uses

**Public Hearing 2:** The purpose of the second public hearing is to consider a special land use application, submitted by Derek Warren, to convert a single-story industrial building, located at 7850 Second Street (08-08-05-230-007), into a self-storage facility. The subject site is zoned I-1, Limited Industrial District.

**Public Hearing 3:** The purpose of the third public hearing is to consider the proposed City of Dexter 2021-2026 Capital Improvements Plan (CIP). The CIP is a program that projects and coordinates public expenditures for improvements to the transportation and utility systems, municipal facilities, and other capital improvement projects over a six-year period. Preparation of the capital improvements plan is done under the authority of the PA 33 of 2008, the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, as amended. It is the Planning Commission's goal that the CIP be used as a tool to implement the City's Master Plan and assist is the City's financial planning.
